Fruit-calyx cylindrical-obconic, with 10 deep furrows extending nearly to the base, surmounted by a ring bearing several rows of hooked spines, containing usually only a single achene; segments connivent, subacute. In dry thickets, hedge-banks, sides of fields, and waste places. Not uncommon, and generally distributed, except in the extreme North of Scotland. England, Scotland, Ireland. Perennial. Summer and Autumn. Rootstock flexuous, not creeping. Stem 1 to 3 feet high, angular, branched in large specimens. Leaves numerous, situated principally towards the base of the stem; leaflets increasing in size towards the apex of the leaf, where they are 1 to 1 inch long, with 5 to 9 deep incisions on each side between the teeth, which are subacute, but with rounded sides. Stipules large, very slightly adnate. Racemes terminal, short while in flower, but lengthening much in fruit, till the principal one occupies half...
