The volume provides detailed information on the histories of dozens of locations, including homes, workshops, business sites, and even the ships and shipyards made famous by Rosie the Riveter in World War II. Readers are invited to visit astronomer Maria Mitchell s Nantucket home, artist Grace Hudson s rural California log studio, Clara Barton s home and Red Cross headquarters, and the Colorado ranch where Adeline Hornbeck successfully homesteaded 10,000 feet above sea level. Other notable sites reveal the achievements and lives of Mary McLeod Bethune, Pearl S. Buck, Julia Grant, and Harriet Beecher Stowe. Entries also highlight key features to examine at each site, including notable paintings and artwork, unique architectural details, and interesting artefacts. The book s extensive resources include a bibliography to books, articles, Web sites, lesson plans for teaching women s history and making the most of nearby sites, and suggested itineraries for tours of sites.
