Pixels with a temperature under -1 C are always consid-ered cloudy. Due to these problems, the normal ice cover documented in the Great Lakes Ice Atlas (Assel et al. , 1983) was used to display the ice cover and ice extent of the Great Lakes. The two datasets, normal ice cover and normal temperature, are derived from different observational bases and with different techniques. Simply replacing all temperature data for each ice-covered grid point yields inconsistencies and unrealistically large temperature gradients, especially during the freez-ing and melting period. Normal ice maps from the normal ice cover data base were available between 23 December and 22 April. In some lake parts, especially in shallow bay areas, parts of the lake already had considerable ice cover. To...
