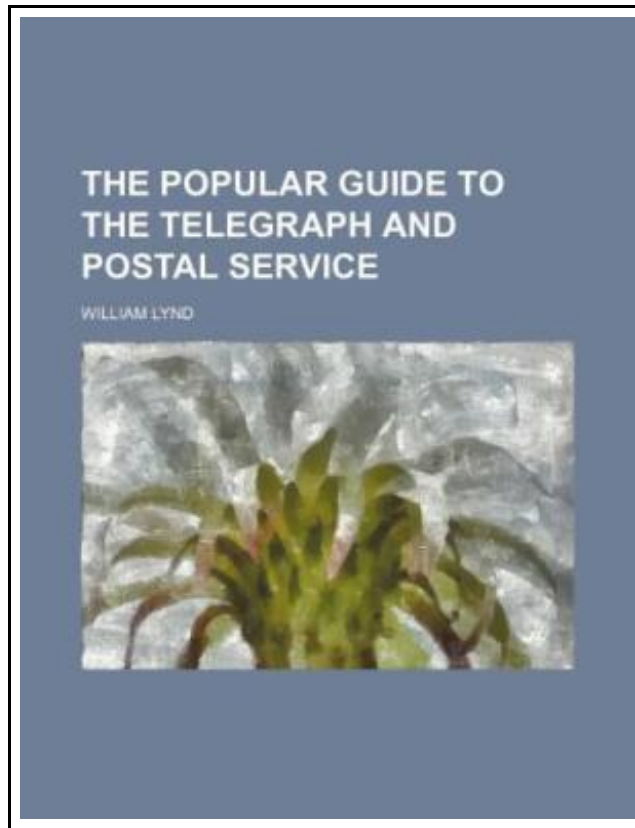

Letter tonight s p5st The message here illustrated was supposed to be handed in at the counter of the Head Telegraph Office, Birmingham. The clerk, seeing it was for Hull, and knowing that the telegram could not be sent to Hull direct, inserted the prefix X, which signified that it was a transmitted message. The form was then sent up to the instrument-room and handed to the clerk at the T.S. (London) wire, who sent it to the Central. The operator at T.S., receiving the prefix X, knew which pad of forms he required, and wrote the message on the yellow or X form. The telegram was then handed to the clerk in charge of the Hull wire, who offered that station S, which signified A message for your town, and the telegraphist at Hull used the pink forms, using carbonic paper, and writing two copies--one for the office, and the other for the addressee.
